ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

(Issued March 24, 2010)

The Postal Service requests an extension until April 30, 2010 to complete a filing to add Stamp Fulfillment Services to the Mail Classification Schedule.¹ In support thereof, the Postal Service states that additional time is needed to determine what to propose and to obtain management and Governors' review.

The request is granted. No responses have been filed in opposition and no participant will be prejudiced by the requested extension.
