**UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE UPDATED RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 286
CONCERNING TERMINATION DATE OF ADDITIONAL GLOBAL EXPEDITED
PACKAGE SERVICES 2 NEGOTIATED SERVICE AGREEMENT**
(March 25, 2010)

On August 24, 2009, the Postal Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued Order No. 286, adding the specific agreement that is the subject of this docket to the Global Expedited Package Services (GEPS) product.¹ In that Order, the Commission directed that the Postal Service give notice of the termination date of the specific agreement and to update that information if it changed. Subsequently, in Order No. 290, the Commission clarified that certain GEPS agreements, including this one, filed after the one in Docket No. CP2009-50 would be included in the GEPS 2 product.² In response to Order No. 286, the Postal Service provided September 6, 2009, as the start date for the specific agreement that is the subject of this docket and September 5, 2010, as the termination date.³

In accordance with Commission Order No. 286, the Postal Service hereby advises that the termination date for the Negotiated Service Agreement that is the subject of this docket will be March 31, 2010. This date coincides with the effective date of a replacement agreement with the customer. As provided in an accompanying notice filed in Docket No. CP2010-26, the effective date of the replacement agreement will be April 1, 2010. Therefore, the Postal Service now asks the Commission to remove contract CP2009-59 from the competitive products list effective on March 31, 2010.
