MOTION OF THE PUBLIC REPRESENTATIVES FOR LEAVE TO FILE REPLY

(March 25, 2010)

Pursuant to rule 21 of the Commission's rules of practice, the Public Representatives hereby request leave to file a reply to the Postal Service's opposition to the Public Representatives' motion for an order to show cause.¹

On March 17, 2010, the Public Representatives filed a motion seeking to have two exhibits to their initial comments in this proceeding made publicly available.² In its answer, the Postal Service acknowledges that some, but not all, of the information contained in the two exhibits can be made publicly available. The Postal Service opposes public availability of the remaining information and has simultaneously filed an application for confidential treatment of that remaining information.

The Public Representatives believe that the confidentiality issues presented by these filings can be summarily resolved and seek leave to file the accompanying reply to the Postal Service Opposition as a means for achieving prompt resolution of those issues. Accordingly, the Public Representatives submit that good cause exists to grant the instant motion.
