CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 1

(Issued March 29, 2010)

Pursuant to 39 CFR § 3015.6, the Postal Service is requested to provide written responses to the following questions. In order to assist in the completion of the record, the responses are to be provided as soon as they are developed, but no later than April 1, 2010.

1. Please refer to the Postal Service's Request, Attachment B, at page 3, where it states that "[t]here is no reason to believe that the boxes being proposed for transfer have a cost coverage below the cost coverage for Post Office box service as a whole." With respect to the potential cost coverage for the new competitive product, please answers the following questions:
 - (a) In FY 2009, the Post Office Box product incurred \$632,255,370 million in total attributable costs. Please distribute the FY 2009 total attributable cost among the eight fee groups.
 - (b) Please provide the revenues for each fee group. If necessary, reconcile the revenues provided with those listed in the billing determinants.

2. Assuming approval of the proposed transfer, please explain how the Postal Service will develop and report costs for the product in the next and subsequent Annual Compliance Report filings.
