OPPOSITION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
TO MOTION OF DAVID B. POPKIN

The United States Postal Service hereby opposes the motion of David B. Popkin, filed March 25, 2010. Mr. Popkin requests that the Postal Service make public the redacted data in Attachment D to its Request in this docket. The redacted data include the number of boxes rented at each location, by box size, and the revenue generated from those boxes. The Postal Service does not believe that any private mailbox providers make similar information publicly available for their locations. Moreover, the Postal Service has filed an unredacted copy of Attachment D in folder MC2010-20/NP1. While this folder is not generally available to the public, an intervenor like Mr. Popkin could obtain full access as long as he agrees to abide by the relevant protective conditions.

The Postal Service disagrees that the redacted data are available to the public through other sources. The Postal Service's website shows whether there is availability of a given size box at a selected location, but not how many are available. The website does not indicate how many boxes are rented, or the resulting revenue, for any particular location. Moreover, "Please Rent Me" signs typically are not placed on every box that is not rented at a particular location. The Postal Service's Address Management organization (and private resellers) provide

mailers with information needed to make a saturation mailing to post office boxes, but do not provide the redacted information (box usage data by box size, and associated revenue information).

The Postal Service therefore requests that the Commission deny Mr. Popkin's motion.
