**APPLICATION OF GAMEFLY, INC.,
FOR NON-PUBLIC TREATMENT OF
TWO DOCUMENTS
(April 12, 2010)**

Pursuant to Rule 3007.22, 39 C.F.R. § 3007.22, GameFly, Inc., applies for nonpublic treatment of two documents that GameFly is filing with the Commission today: (1) the Testimony of Sander Glick (GFL-T-1) and (2) the “Memorandum of GameFly, Inc., Summarizing Documentary Evidence.” The documents contain information produced under seal by the Postal Service in response to GameFly discovery requests.

GameFly is separately filing a redacted version of GFL-T-1 with the Commission today. Because of the pervasiveness of the non-public information in the Memorandum, a redacted version of that document would be largely unintelligible, and we have not prepared one at this time. GameFly will file revised versions of both documents, including public

versions, after the Commission rules on GameFly's pending requests to unseal much of the sealed information.
