**ERRATUM TO UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE RESPONSE TO ORDER NO.
248 CONCERNING THE TERMINATION DATE OF INBOUND DIRECT ENTRY
CONTRACTS NEGOTIATED SERVICE AGREEMENT**
(April 12, 2010)

On July 15, 2009, the Postal Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued Order No. 248, adding the Inbound Direct Entry (IDE) contract with P&T Express Mail Service Joint Stock Company (VNPE) to the Competitive Products List.¹ In that Order, the Commission requested that the Postal Service give notice of the effective dates of the agreement. By notice filed on July 16, 2009, the Postal Service identified August 1, 2009, as the start date for the agreement and July 31, 2010, as the termination date. Upon review of this filing, the Postal Service recently discovered that it provided an incorrect termination date for the contract. Accordingly, the Postal Service provides this Erratum, which corrects the previously submitted termination date.

As indicated in the Postal Service's initial Notice in this docket, the agreement has a one-year term with automatic renewal, essentially remaining in effect until terminated by the parties.² Although scheduled termination is not a feature of the

agreement, the Postal Service will provide the Commission with timely notification of any termination of the agreement, in accordance with Order No. 248.
