**NOTICE OF INTERVENTION OF
ALLIANCE OF NONPROFIT MAILERS
(April 21, 2010)**

The Alliance of Nonprofit Mailers (“ANM”) submits this Notice of Intervention pursuant to Order No. 436 and section 20 of the Commission’s Rules. In accordance with that rule, ANM states as follows:

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2. ANM is a nonprofit corporation, chartered in the District of Columbia, representing the interests of nonprofit organizations in postal rate matters. ANM's members include many of the Nation's best-known charitable, religious, educational,

scientific and other nonprofit organizations, as well as smaller community organizations and their umbrella groups. ANM has a significant interest in the Postal Service's proposal to eliminate one day of delivery, as this change would have a major effect on the operations and mailing strategies of its members. At the same time, ANM also has an interest in the ability of the Postal Service to minimize avoidable costs and remain solvent.

3. ANM intends to actively participate in this proceeding, but does not request a hearing at this time.
