Forever Stamps

~~The~~ Forever ~~S~~stamps ~~is~~are sold at the prevailing price for single-piece letters, first ounce, in First-Class Mail. Once purchased, ~~the~~ Forever ~~S~~stamps may be used for postage equal to the prevailing price, at the time of use, for single-piece letters, first ounce, in First-Class Mail. ~~The~~ Forever ~~S~~stamps ~~is~~are intended for the prepayment of postage for the first ounce of First-Class Mail single-piece letter mail, and otherwise may be used for the prepayment of postage.
