**NOTICE OF GAMEFLY, INC., OF
RESOLUTION OF DISCOVERY ISSUE
(May 6, 2010)**

GameFly, Inc. (“GameFly”) hereby gives notice that it has reached agreement with the Postal Service on the means by which the Postal Service will make available for review the emails that reside on the Postal Service’s centralized email database (and which were discussed at yesterday’s scheduling conference). The Postal Service has agreed to make two separate computer stations available for review of the emails at Postal Service headquarters. GameFly withdraws its request for production of the emails in a CD or DVD delivered to the premises of GameFly’s counsel.

Resolution of this issue leaves the setting of a discovery cutoff date and a filing date for the Postal Service’s direct testimony as the only remaining procedural issues now before the Commission. GameFly appreciates the Commission’s determination to set those dates as expeditiously as possible.
