**MOTION FOR MODIFICATION OF SCHEDULE  
TO ACCOMMODATE RELIGIOUS OBSERVANCE**

TO: Presiding Officer Ruth Y. Goldway

The undersigned counsel for Intervenor National Association of Letter Carriers, AFL-CIO (“NALC”) hereby moves for a modification of the Procedural Schedule issued on April 28, 2010, to accommodate a religious observance. The Procedural Schedule provides that the Hearing to enter rebuttal testimony into the record shall take place September 7-10, 2010. The Jewish New Year (*Rosh-HaShanah*), which is one of the holiest days in the Jewish calendar, begins on the evening of September 8, 2010 and continues through September 9. NALC’s counsel intends to travel to New York City from Washington DC on the afternoon of September 8 to attend religious services that evening and again on September 9. If the Hearing proceeds as scheduled, NALC’s counsel will be compelled by this religious observance to miss part of the Hearing, thereby depriving NALC of its opportunity to participate fully in the case. Accordingly, counsel for NALC hereby respectfully requests that the Procedural Schedule be modified so that there is no hearing day scheduled for the afternoon of September 8 or for September 9.
