**ERRATA TO DOUGLAS F. CARLSON
MOTION TO COMPEL THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
TO RESPOND TO INTERROGATORY DFC/USPS-T4-14**

In the motion that I filed on May 10, 2010, to compel the Postal Service to respond to interrogatory DFC/USPS-T4-14,¹ I identified, by way of example, a possible Saturday mail processing consolidation involving the Sacramento, San Francisco, and Oakland P&DC's. I noted that this consolidation would cross two districts, Bay-Valley and San Francisco. I observed that a headquarters-level consolidation initiative might allow for additional opportunities for savings by crossing district boundaries and avoiding "silo" behavior in the organization.

This consolidation actually would cross *three* districts: Bay-Valley, San Francisco, and Sacramento.
