At USPS-T-7 at 17, you state “Future years will have higher hourly labor costs and input unit costs, a greater number of delivery points to serve, and most likely lower mail volumes.” You then note: “Actual savings obtainable in the coming years will be affected by these somewhat offsetting factors.”

Please clarify the use of the term “offsetting” (in connection with actual savings) with respect to each of the factors referred to above, including the impact of each factor relative to the others.
