Postcom/USPS-T3-1. Please refer further to your response to APWU/USPS-T3-3, in which you state that in lieu of additional overtime hours to handle increased volume on Fridays, Mondays, and Tuesdays, your “preferred solution to increased workload would be to curtail non-committed mail.”

(a) Has the Postal Service developed or implemented any standards for determining when non-committed mail will be curtailed versus when other tools will be used to handle this workload, “such as any undertime on another route, auxiliary assistance and overtime.”

(b) If such standards have been created, please produce them.

(c) If such standards have not been created, does the Postal Service plan to create, implement, and publicize such standards?
