



7) the Postal Service provided formal notice on the record in the June 16 hearing that it would be filing additional follow up discovery that would be one day late; and 8) two postal attorneys, Messrs. Mecone and Hollies, have large workloads handling other litigation, including PRC Docket No. N2010-1, that limits the time available for review of the extensive materials filed by GameFly on June 9, 2010, and evaluation for necessary follow up.

For these reasons, therefore, the United States Postal Service moves for late acceptance of the discovery directed to GameFly and filed this date.
