The United States Postal Service hereby moves for the late filing of witness Whiteman's responses to APWU/USPS-T9-1-8, filed May 28, 2010. These responses are accordingly 12 days late. The late filing of these responses was caused by the need for cross-functional coordination, and spirited discussion regarding the approach that should be taken in the responses. The unavailability of the undersigned counsel, who has several major cases ongoing, was also a critical factor causing these responses to be late. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but believes that no party has been prejudiced by it.
