The American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO hereby moves for late acceptance of its Motion to Compel the Postal Service to Respond to APWU/USPS-T2-7. As a result of an internet glitch, the Motion to Compel, due June 21, 2010, was filed seconds late on the due date and thus, was technically one day late in filing. APWU believes that the USPS will not be harmed by this delay as Postal Service counsel was informed that the Motion to Compel would be filed. Postal Service counsel was also provided with a courtesy copy of the Motion to Compel yesterday evening. Further, the Motion to Compel should post to the public docket listing first thing this morning. APWU believes that no other party will be prejudiced by this minimal delay.
