The Postal Service hereby gives notice of the filing of the material indicated below in this proceeding:

N2010-1/18 Materials Responsive to Chairman's Information Request No. 5,
Question 7(b)-(c)

N2010-1/NP7 Response to Chairman's Information Request No. 5, Question 8

As indicated, this material relates to two questions in Chairman's Information Request No. 5. The first Library Reference consists of data and analysis supporting witness Grossmann's testimony regarding the opportunity for reduction in surface transportation in a five-day delivery environment. The second Library Reference contains commercially sensitive and proprietary information about historical volumes and weights that have been transported on the Postal Service's behalf by its contractor, FedEx. Because these data should not be released into the public domain, such information has been redacted in the public version of the file that accompanies the Postal Service's response to Chairman's Information Request No. 5. In contrast, Library Reference NP7, filed under seal, contains the full, unredacted version of the

same material. As suggested by the relevant question in the Chairman's Information Request, these data underlie the analysis in non-public Library Reference USPS-LR-N2010-1/NP1, and they consist of similar classes of data (contractor volumes and weights), to which the same justification for non-public treatment applies as with Library Reference NP1. Therefore, the Postal Service incorporates the application for non-public treatment of Library Reference NP1, filed on March 30, 2010, in its instant filing of Library Reference NP7.
