**NOTICE OF INTENT OF INTERVENOR NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF LETTER  
CARRIERS, AFL-CIO TO CONDUCT ORAL CROSS-EXAMINATION OF USPS  
WITNESSES**

Pursuant to Rule 30(e)(3) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and the Commission's April 28, 2010 Procedural Schedule in this case, Intervenor National Association of Letter Carriers, AFL-CIO ("NALC") hereby provides notice of its intent to conduct oral cross-examination of the following USPS witnesses:

1. Samuel Pulcrano (USPS-T-1) -- The topics to be covered include the claimed need to eliminate Saturday delivery and the impact and consequences, including on postal customers, of the proposed elimination of Saturday delivery. Cross-examination will make reference to pages 2, 3, 4, and 6 of Mr. Pulcrano's testimony. NALC estimates that its cross-examination will be medium to heavy.
2. Joseph Corbett (USPS-T-2) -- The topics to be covered include the claimed financial need to eliminate Saturday delivery and projections regarding future mail volume. Cross-examination will make reference to pages 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 15 and 16 of Mr. Corbett's testimony. NALC estimates that its cross-examination will be heavy.
3. Dean J. Granholm (USPS-T-3) -- The topics to be covered include the operational impact of the proposed elimination of Saturday delivery, including the impact on letter carrier work hours. Cross-examination will make reference to pages 5, 9, 11, 12, 13 of Mr.

Granholm's testimony and also to USPS-LR-N2010-1/3. NALC estimates that its cross-examination will be heavy.

4. Michael D. Bradley (USPS-T-6) -- The topics to be covered include the estimated savings from the proposed elimination of Saturday delivery, including the savings from letter carrier costs. Cross-examination will make reference to pages 1-20, 50-53 of Mr. Bradley's testimony and also to USPS-LR-N2010-1/6. NALC estimates that its cross-examination will be medium to heavy.

5. Gregory M. Whiteman (USPS-T-9) -- The topic to be covered include the estimated impact of the proposed elimination of Saturday delivery on mail volume, including marketing research concerning such estimate. Cross-examination will make reference to pages 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8-13 of Mr. Whiteman's testimony. NALC estimates that its cross-examination will be medium to heavy.
