MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF FILING OF ITS RESPONSE
TO QUESTION 5 OF CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 5
(June 30, 2010)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance today of the filing of its responses to Question 5 of Chairman's Information Request No. 5. The response was due on June 25, 2010, and is 5 calendar and 3 business days late. Witness Whiteman and his staff were among approximately 400 people at Headquarters whose offices were moved last week. When efforts to complete the response before the move failed, the resulting circumstances impeded timely filing. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but considers it unlikely that any party has suffered any prejudice as a result.
