Cross-examination subjects and the extent of anticipated cross-examination are identified in the attachment to this notice.

The Public Representatives also respectfully request that they be allowed to reserve an opportunity to conduct follow-up cross-examination with respect to responses elicited through oral cross-examination conducted by others.
