MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF
RESPONSES TO INTERROGATORIES NNA/USPS-T8-5, 7-11
(July 12, 2010)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for the late filing of witness Elmore-Yalch's responses to NNA/USPS-T8-5, 7-11, filed June 7, 2010. These interrogatories have undergone extensive inter-departmental review that proved difficult to complete in the allotted time. However, they were completed on Jun 25, 2010. Counsel discovered late on July 9 that he had failed to file the finished responses. Copies of the responses were accordingly sent directly to counsel for NNA that same day.
