**MOTION BY NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF LETTER CARRIERS, AFL-CIO FOR  
LATE ACCEPTANCE OF ITS DESIGNATION OF WRITTEN CROSS-EXAMINATION  
OF USPS WITNESS DEAN GRANHOLM (USPS-T-3)**

The National Association of Letter Carriers, AFL-CIO (“NALC”) hereby moves for late acceptance of its Designation of Written Cross-Examination of USPS Witness Dean Granholm (USPS-T-3), filed July 12, 2010.

Pursuant to the Presiding Officer’s July 8, 2010 Ruling on Procedural Matters, the designation of written cross-examination of USPS witness Granholm was due the next day, Friday, July 9. NALC, by inadvertence, filed its designation one business day late, on Monday, July 12, 2010. To minimize any possible prejudice to USPS or its witness from the late filing, NALC on Saturday, July 10, emailed a copy of its designation to Brian Reimer, the USPS attorney designated to represent Mr. Granholm. Because the one business day delay in NALC’s filing is minimal and will not prejudice either USPS or its witness, and because allowing NALC’s designation will help provide a full evidentiary record in this proceeding, NALC respectfully requests that the instant motion for late acceptance be granted.
