MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF FILING OF ITS RESPONSE

(July 12, 2010)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance today of the filing of its response to Question 17 of Chairman's Information Request No. 6. The response was due on July 9, 2010, and is 3 calendar days and 1 business day late. The response required substantial data processing at the Eagan PDC over the holiday weekend and at other off-peak times, precluding any earlier response. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but considers it unlikely that any party has suffered any prejudice as a result.
