GREETING CARD ASSOCIATION MOTION FOR LEAVE TO
FILE SUPPLEMENTAL DESIGNATIONS OF WRITTEN CROSS EXAMINATION

The Greeting Card Association (GCA) respectfully moves for leave to file supplemental designations of written cross examination for Postal Service witness Granholm.

GCA initially filed, and on May 28, 2010, received answers to, eight interrogatories to Mr. Granholm¹. On June 30, 2010, the date provided for followup interrogatories in POR No. 1², GCA filed several such interrogatories to Mr. Granholm (GCA/USPS-T3-9 through -T3-14). Answers to these were filed on July 12, 2010. POR No. 14 (July 8, 2010), however, established July 9, 2010, as the date on which designations for Mr. Granholm were due. Consequently, on that date GCA was able only to designate material from the initial (May 28) batch as written cross examination.³

Accordingly, GCA now requests permission to file the accompanying designation of the followup interrogatories and the answers thereto received on July 12. We submit that this filing will prejudice no party and will enhance the record.
