GREETING CARD ASSOCIATION MOTION FOR LEAVE
TO AMEND NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONDUCT ORAL CROSS EXAMINATION

On July 9, 2010, the Greeting Card Association (GCA) filed its Notice of Intent to Conduct Oral Cross Examination, listing four witnesses (Mr. Granholm, Dr. Bradley, Dr. Colvin, and Ms. Elmore-Yalch). Subsequently, the Postal Service filed objections to GCA's followup interrogatories to Ms. Elmore-Yalch and to Mr. Whiteman, whom GCA had not included in the Notice. Both the Service's objection and GCA's July 16 response to it adverted to the possibility of dealing with the substance of the challenged interrogatories at the hearing. For reasons set forth in our motions for leave to file designations for Mr. Whiteman and Ms. Elmore-Yalch, GCA believes that this may be the best course. Consequently, we respectfully request leave to amend our July 9 Notice by adding Mr. Whiteman.

An amended Notice of Intent to Conduct Oral Cross Examination is being filed concurrently with this Motion.
