MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF
WITNESS LUTTRELL'S TESTIMONY (PR-T-2)

The Public Representatives hereby move for acceptance of the testimony of Edward Luttrell, president of the National Grange of the Order of Patrons of Husbandry (PR-T-2), one day out of time. The late filing was caused, among other things, by an unanticipated delay in coordinating final review and receipt of the testimony prior to the 4:30 p.m. filing deadline and, in part, to time zone differences.

Postal Service counsel was alerted to the need for late filing late yesterday afternoon.

The Public Representatives regret the inconvenience to the Commission, the Postal Service, and other participants, but believe that actual harm will be minimal or non-existent, given the brief delay in filing.
