- 1) Does the Postal Service consider the impact of its rates and services on the overall economy, specific business sectors, and private sector job creation when it formulates changes in rates and services?
- 2) The Postal Service has recommended the elimination of Saturday delivery in the context of moving to a five delivery-day operating schedule. While eBay believes that reducing a service day offers a valuable cost-savings option that deserves very serious consideration, eBay believes that eliminating Saturday delivery removes a very competitive and valuable package delivery service that is useful to small business retailers. Is the Postal Service considering a non-Saturday alternative to achieve the goal of moving to five delivery days?
- 3) What steps is the Postal Service taking to ensure greatly flexibility in pursuing new product and service lines? What types of product and service lines does the Postal Service anticipate will be open for discussion with its partners?
- 4) What steps is the Postal Service taking to ensure they can drive additional cost efficiencies by closing/moving post office locations? How will the Postal Service apply cost benefits from closing/moving post office locations to mitigate any increase in proposed postal rates? Is the Postal Service considering the sale of unneeded property and facilities as a way to raise capital that could be better used to grow the business?
