USPS/PR-T2-25.

Please refer to page 6, line 1 of your testimony. Please provide such information and copies of such records as the National Grange may possess that indicate how many states require that, in order for them to be counted, mailed election ballots must be:

- (a) received by the responsible local elections board by close of business on election day;
- (b) postmarked on or before election day.

USPS/PR-T2-26.

Is it your belief that the postal delivery of election ballots addressed to a Post Office Box will be affected by the elimination of postal delivery to street addresses on Saturdays? If so, please explain.

USPS/PR-T2-27.

Please provide such information and copies of such records as the National Grange may possess that indicate the extent to which local government elections boards use Post Office Box addresses for the postal delivery of election ballots.
