MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF
INITIAL COMMENTS OF THE
NATIONAL POSTAL MAIL HANDLERS UNION
REGARDING POSTAL SERVICE REQUEST FOR A RATE ADJUSTMENT
DUE TO EXTRAORDINARY OR EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES

The National Postal Mail Handlers Union (“NPMHU”) hereby moves for late acceptance of its Initial Comments regarding the Postal Service’s pending request for a rate adjustment that exceeds the rate of inflation pursuant to Section 3622(d)(1)(E) of the Postal Enhancement and Accountability Act of 2006 (“PAEA”), 39 U.S.C. § 3622(d)(1)(E).

NPMHU’s Initial Comments were due on August 17, 2010. Several attempts were made to file the comments prior to the PRC’s 4:30 p.m. filing deadline. Each of these attempts resulted in an error message providing a support number to call. A support call was placed and during this call the filing was once again attempted but was unsuccessful. NPMHU was instructed to wait to be contacted the following day when a technical representative at the Commission was available to ascertain the nature of the

error and assist with the filing. That assistance was obtained the morning of August 18, 2010 and the document was successfully filed.

NPMHU believes that no party will be prejudiced by this brief delay.
