OASIS02 Open Ends.pdf	Answers to open-ended questions in the survey.
OASIS02 Opens Excel.xls	Answers to open-ended questions by respondent.
OASIS02 Sample Report.pdf	Sample size and response rates to the survey.
OASIS 2002 Toplines.pdf	Distribution of answers to each survey question based on including and excluding missing values.
