

The Alliance of Nonprofit Mailers ("ANM") respectfully requests that the Commission accept its reply to the January 30 objection of the United States Postal Service to National Federation of Nonprofits Interrogatory NFN/ANM-T1-1 one day out of time (*see* Presiding Officer's Ruling No. R97-1/92 (Feb. 4, 1998)).
