Is your concern about the Postal Service's proposal in this docket actually focused more on the elimination of collection and processing of outgoing mail on Saturdays than on the elimination of carrier delivery on Saturdays?

RESPONSE:

The possibility of negative repercussions from both aspects of the Postal Service's proposed service reduction is of great concern to me. However, the elimination of collection and processing on Saturdays is particularly problematic, given the length of time it takes to transmit ballots.
