MOTION FOR ACCEPTANCE OF  
REVISED RESPONSE OF PUBLIC REPRESENTATIVES' WITNESS BROWN  
TO UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE INTERROGATORY  
(USPS/PR-T1-4(B))

(September 9, 2010)

The Public Representatives hereby move for acceptance of a revised response of Public Representatives' witness Brown to United States Postal Service interrogatory USPS/PR-T1-4(b).

Further review of a document referred to as "Ballot Statistics," which has been filed in this docket in response to interrogatory DBP/PR-T1-1, indicates that use of an Excel spreadsheet formula yields a percentage of 50% instead of 49%. The latter figure was obtained via a hand-held calculator. In addition, the revised response clarifies that the "universe" referred to in the response is for timely-filed ballots, not all ballots.

The Public Representatives further note that the original response to this subpart was part of a multi-response filing, and a page associated with that response appeared out of order. The filing of this response, including the original responses to other subparts, allows that matter to be corrected.

The Public Representatives regret any inconvenience to the United States Postal Service, the Commission, or others occasioned by this revised response, but believe that this revision will provide greater accuracy and clarity.
