**APPLICATION OF GAMEFLY, INC.,  
FOR NON-PUBLIC TREATMENT OF PORTIONS OF  
TWO DOCUMENTS FILED BY GAMEFLY TODAY  
(September 14, 2010)**

Pursuant to Rule 3007.22, 39 C.F.R. § 3007.22, GameFly, Inc. (“GameFly”) applies for nonpublic treatment of certain portions of GameFly’s (1) Motion to Compel the Postal Service to Answer GameFly Discovery Requests GFL/USPS-225 to 233 and 235, and (2) follow-up discovery requests GFL/USPS-T4-44-49 to USPS witness Robert Lundahl.

The portions of the documents that GameFly is filing under seal are descriptions of the substance of contain reports prepared by a consultant for Netflix and produced by the Postal Service in discovery on August 31, 2010. GameFly takes no position on whether the information merits protection under the Commission’s standards for protective conditions. GameFly is filing the information under seal because the Postal Service marked the reports as confidential Netflix information before producing the documents in discovery to GameFly.

GameFly has today filed proprietary versions of the two documents under seal with the Commission, and served of the same documents upon counsel for the Postal Service and Netflix.
