PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING SCHEDULING WITNESSES
AND OTHER PROCEDURAL MATTERS

(Issued September 29, 2010)

A hearing to receive surrebuttal testimony from the Postal Service's witnesses is scheduled for October 4, 2010 at 9:30 a.m.

Two of the Postal Service's four surrebuttal witnesses have been noticed for cross-examination. Peter Boatwright (USPS-RT-1) and Melissa Starr (USPS-RT-3) shall appear on October 4, 2010 at 9:30 a.m. However, as no party has provided notice of intent to cross-examine witnesses Alan Moore (USPS-RT-2) and Samuel Pulcrano (USPS-RT-4), they are excused, and their testimony shall be entered into the record on Monday, October 4, 2010.

Procedural matters. An unopposed motion for acceptance of a designated interrogatory filed by David B. Popkin is outstanding. Acceptance of this motion will not prejudice any party and will facilitate development of a full evidentiary record. For these reasons, the motion is granted.

RULING

1. Postal Service surrebuttal witnesses Peter Boatwright (USPS-RT-1) and Melissa Starr (USPS-RT-3) shall appear at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, October 4, 2010 for the hearing to enter their testimony into the record.
2. Postal Service surrebuttal witnesses Alan Moore (USPS-RT-2) and Samuel Pulcrano (USPS-RT-4) are excused from the hearing.
3. The Motion Concerning Acceptance of Notice of Designated Interrogatory (DBP/PR-T1-1), filed September 13, 2010, is granted.
