**NOTICE OF ERRATA  
CONCERNING EFFECTIVE DATE FOR GLOBAL EXPEDITED PACKAGE  
SERVICES--NON-PUBLISHED RATES  
SERIAL NUMBERS 0001-0021  
(February 9, 2011)**

On January 14, 2011, the United States Postal Service gave notice of filing customer agreements with serial numbers ending in 0001 through 0021. A subsequent notice filed on January 24, 2011, informed that the effective date for one mailer's agreement (NPR2-FY11-DEC10-M-T7-0019) had been adjusted. Since that time, however, review of the original notice concerning agreements 0001-0021 revealed that a typographical error, repeated for all of the agreements, incorrectly cited 2010 as the year in which these contracts begin. The attached notice corrects the effective dates, including the adjusted date applicable to the agreement with the serial number ending in 0019 and should replace the original notice filed on January 14, 2011 in this docket.

**CUSTOMER CONTRACT FILING NOTICE FOR  
GLOBAL EXPEDITED PACKAGE SERVICES--NON-PUBLISHED RATES  
SERIAL NUMBERS ENDING: 0001 THROUGH 0021  
(January 14, 2011)**

In compliance with Order No. 630,<sup>1</sup> the United States Postal Service gives notice of filing customer agreements with serial numbers ending in 0001 through 0021<sup>2</sup> and the inputs used to generate customer-specific pricing for those agreements. The effective dates for these agreements are listed below. A redacted version of the inputs used to generate the customer-specific rate tables for 20 of the 21 agreements is filed electronically in its native format. Because the redacted version of the inputs for the remaining contract, which has the serial number ending in 0019, will appear the same, it has not been provided publicly, but it has been provided under seal to the Commission. The customer agreements were all generated from the model agreement filed in this

<sup>2</sup> The full serial number, which contains fields useful to the Postal Service's administration of the contracts, appears on the first page of each contract. For example, the contract ending in 0001 has the full serial number, NPR2-FY11-NOV10-M-T2-0001. The Postal Service believes that for the Commission's purposes, identifying the contracts by the final four digits, which will be sequential as the serial numbers are assigned to new contracts, simplifies the notice title. The full serial numbers are provided elsewhere in the body of the notice. If the Commission indicates a preference for the full serial numbers to be used in the notice title, the Postal Service will adjust its practice.

docket as Attachment 3 to the Postal Service's original Notice.<sup>3</sup> Because all of the redacted agreements are derived from a common model, which is a document of over 20 pages (often over 4 MB electronically), and would appear essentially the same when redacted, only a representative agreement, NPR2-FY11-NOV10-M-T2-0001, is filed publicly as Attachment 1. All of the unredacted contracts are being filed with the Commission under seal.
