(February 17, 2011)

On March 31, 2010, the Postal Regulatory Commission (Commission), issued Order No. 433, adding the specific agreement that is the subject of the above referenced docket to the Global Expedited Package Services 2 product.<sup>1</sup> Attached to this notice is a modification to that contract. The modification corrects a typographical error concerning the last name of the individual listed as the contact for the Mailer in Article 28 of the agreement. A redacted version is filed publicly as Attachment 1, while the unredacted version of the modification is filed under seal. With respect to the non-public version of the modification which is filed under seal, the Postal Service hereby incorporates its Application for Non-Public Treatment, filed in conjunction with its March 18, 2010, notice in this docket.<sup>2</sup>

**MODIFICATION ONE TO THE  
GLOBAL CUSTOMIZED MAIL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE AND**

This Modification amends the Global Customized Mail Agreement ("Agreement") between [REDACTED] ("Mailer") with offices at [REDACTED] and the United States Postal Service ("USPS"), an independent establishment of the Executive Branch of the United States Government, with offices at 475 L'Enfant Plaza SW, Washington, DC 20260-9998, signed by the Mailer on February 3, 2010, and by the USPS on February 5, 2010, pursuant to Article 14 of the Agreement. The Mailer and the USPS may be referred to individually as a "Party" and together as the "Parties."

The Mailer acknowledges that the Modification and supporting documentation will be filed with the Postal Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in a docket proceeding (CP2010-27). The Mailer authorizes the USPS to determine the scope of information that must be made publicly available in any Commission docketed proceeding. The Mailer further understands that any unredacted portion of the Modification or supporting information will be available on the Commission's public website, <http://www.prc.gov>. The Mailer has the right, in accordance with the Commission's rules, to address its confidentiality concerns directly with the Commission. The procedure for making an application to the Postal Regulatory Commission for non-public treatment of materials believed to be protected from disclosure is found at Title 39, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 3007.22 found on the Commission's website, <http://www.prc.gov/Docs/63/63467/Order225.pdf>.

Article 28 NOTICES is modified to read as follows:

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in force.




