



NOTICE OF FILING UNDER 39 U.S.C. § 404(d)

TO THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE:

Please take notice that on February 15, 2011, the Commission received a petition for review of the Postal Service's determination to close the Pleasant Ridge Station in Little Rock, Arkansas. The petition for review was filed by Lou Schickel (Petitioner) and is postmarked February 7, 2011.

This notice is advisory only and is being furnished so that the Postal Service may begin assembling the administrative record in advance of any formal appeal proceedings held upon the alleged (closing/consolidation) for transmittal pursuant to 39 CFR § 3001.113(a) (requiring the filing of the record within 15 days of the filing with the Commission of a petition for review). The Postal Service's administrative record is due no later than March 2, 2011.

I would like to appeal the closing of the Pleasant Ridge Station which serves me personally and my businesses listed above. The Pleasant Ridge Station is in the fastest growing part of Little Rock and is at the hub of our community. In just a one mile radius there are over 134 businesses, 800 Apartments, 3 established single family neighborhoods, Churches and Schools. Any savings to the Postal Service would pale in comparison to the cost that our businesses and neighbors will incur.

I was contacted by phone on January 25, 2011; however, there has never been an official notice of "Final Determination" posted at the facility. There is certainly nothing posted to instruct patrons of their 30 day right to appeal. There is one very small news article taped to a side door. I doubt that any customers will see it because I was specifically searching for it and almost missed it.

I could write many pages about the issues I have had with this determination process and would be happy to elaborate if you feel it is necessary. Thank you for your assistance. I appreciate your attention to this matter.
