The Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of its responses to questions 1-6 of Chairman's Information Request No. 1, issued on February 16, 2011. The responses were due on February 23, 2011. The two-day delay was caused by the need to coordinate, across functions, extensive and detailed responses to lengthy and complicated questions, and the unexpected absence of personnel key to that coordination. The Postal Service submits that no party is likely to be prejudiced by this brief delay.
