**NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OF FILING  
MODIFICATION TO INBOUND MARKET DOMINANT MULTI-SERVICE AGREEMENT  
WITH HONGKONG POST**  
(March 3, 2011)

On January 31, 2011, the Postal Service filed a Notice of a type 2 rate adjustment and a functionally equivalent agreement in this proceeding.<sup>1</sup> Attached to this notice is a modification to the Agreement filed as Attachment 2 to the Postal Service's Notice. The modification revises the first price chart in Annex 1 of the agreement to include a rate category that had been inadvertently omitted from the original version of the Agreement. A redacted version is filed publicly as Attachment 1 to this notice, while the unredacted version of the modification is filed under seal. With respect to the non-public version of the modification, the Postal Service hereby incorporates the Application for Non-Public Treatment filed as Attachment 1 to its initial Notice in this docket.<sup>2</sup>

**MODIFICATION TO HONGKONG POST – UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
 LETTER POST BILATERAL AGREEMENT**

This Modification amends the Letter Post Bilateral Agreement (“Agreement”) between the United States Postal Service (“USPS”), an independent establishment of the Executive Branch of the United States Government, with offices at 475 L’Enfant Plaza SW, Washington, DC 20260-9998, and HongKong Post (“HongKong Post”), a government branch of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of People’s Republic of China, and having a place of business at 4/F HongKong Post Headquarters 2 Connaught Place, Central, Hong Kong. This Agreement was signed by HongKong Post on January 27, 2011, and signed by the USPS on January 28, 2011. HongKong Post and the USPS may be referred to individually as a “Party” and together as the “Parties.”

The purpose of this Modification is to revise the first price chart (“Hong Kong to the USA”) in Annex 1 of the Agreement. That price chart shall now read as follows:


All other terms and conditions of the Agreement, including the original footnotes to the above-referenced price chart, shall remain in force.

HongKong Post acknowledges that this Modification and supporting documentation will be filed with the Postal Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) in a docketed proceeding (R2011-4). Article 13(2) of the Agreement applies to the filing of this Modification.

The Parties may execute this Modification in one or more counterparts (including by facsimile or by electronic means such as .pdf format). Not all Parties need be signatories to the same document. All counterpart signed documents shall be deemed an original and one instrument.


IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties agree to be bound as of the latest date of signature to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
