REQUEST FOR TECHNICAL CONFERENCE
(March 4, 2011)

On February 7, 2011, the Commission established this proceeding to consider modifications to the Commission's rules governing the Mail Classification Schedule. Order No. 666 (February 7, 2011). The Commission requests comments, by March 24, 2011, on these modifications, which include detailed text for the Mail Classification Schedule, based to some extent on product descriptions provided earlier by the Postal Service in Docket No. RM2007-1. Based on its preliminary review of the Commission's materials, the Postal Service believes that an informal technical conference to discuss details of the Mail Classification Schedule language would help to make the formal commenting simpler and more efficient. The Postal Service suggests that such a conference be held during the week of March 14, or early the following week.
