ORDER DISMISSING APPEALS FOR LACK OF JURISDICTION

(Issued March 22, 2011)

The Commission has before it two appeals seeking review of the Postal Service's decision to consolidate the Daytona Beach Processing & Distribution Facility.¹ The Commission's jurisdiction under 39 U.S.C. 404(d) does not extend to Postal Service determinations to close or consolidate processing and distribution facilities.² Neither of the Petitions raises an issue subject to appeal under section 404(d). Thus, the Petitions are dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.
