On August 2, 2011, the United States Postal Service filed a Response to Order No. 783. This response contained a number of revised pages of the Administrative Record. Basically, the pages now show the number of Post Office Box customers served by the Valley Falls Station. The total number of Post Office Boxes at the Valley Falls Station remains redacted.

This information should be provided in this Docket as well as future Dockets. The data is available to any individual by just going to the facility and counting the boxes on the wall. While that may be convenient for a local resident, it certainly would not be for someone located away from the specific facility.

The number of potential customers that are capable of being affected and the potential for expansion by the discontinuance of a facility will be an important factor to be considered and should be available for participants to utilize in their pleadings.

The redaction of this information should be removed and made public since it is already public. The Postal Service should not be able to make non-public information

that is already in the public domain. It is also noted that similar redactions probably exist in other similar dockets.
