**UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO

On September 1, 2011, the Presiding Officer issued Presiding Officer's Ruling No. N2011-1/5, directing the Postal Service to "provide specific estimates of dates when responses, including all applicable data or library references, will be available for [certain identified] discovery responses."
