PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING  
GRANTING AMERICAN POSTAL WORKERS UNION, AFL-CIO, MOTION  
FOR ACCESS TO NON-PUBLIC INFORMATION

(Issued September 9, 2011)

On September 9, 2011, the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO (APWU) filed a motion to allow certain of its representatives, consultants, and attorneys to review the materials filed in the non-public annex of this docket as library references USPS-LR-N2011-1/NP4 through USPS-LR-N2011-1/NP9.<sup>1</sup>

The Motion, which was filed pursuant to 39 CFR 3007.40 and rule 21 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, acknowledges the APWU's willingness to comply with protective conditions and identifies the individuals to be granted access. The Motion states that APWU discussed the issue with Postal Service counsel and that the Postal Service does not oppose APWU having access to these non-public materials pursuant to the protective conditions.
