**NOTICE OF UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE RESPONSE
TO COMMISSION REQUEST**
(September 12, 2011)

On September 21, 2010, the Postal Regulatory Commission (Commission) issued Order No. 542, adding the specific agreement that is the subject of the instant docket to the Global Expedited Package Services 3 product (MC2010-28).¹ In Order No. 542, the Commission requested that the Postal Service provide cost, volume and revenue data associated with the agreement that is the subject of this docket.²

Because the Mailer never established an effective date with the Postal Service for this agreement, the Postal Service did not provide the Commission with an effective date for this agreement. As a result, the Mailer did not mail any Qualifying Mail under the agreement, and there is no cost, volume or revenue data to file with the Commission associated with the agreement that is the subject of this docket.
