NOTICE OF FILING UNDER 39 U.S.C. § 404(d)

TO THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE:

Please take notice that on September 15, 2011, the Commission received a petition for review of the Postal Service's determination to close the Coyote post office located in Coyote, New Mexico. The petition for review was filed by Manuelita Trujillo on behalf of the Concerned Citizens of the Coyote Post Office (Petitioner) and was received by the Commission on September 12, 2011.

This notice is advisory only and is being furnished so that the Postal Service may begin assembling the administrative record in advance of any formal appeal proceedings held upon the alleged (closing/consolidation) for transmittal pursuant to 39 CFR § 3001.113(a) (requiring the filing of the record within 15 days of the filing with the Commission of a petition for review). The Postal Service's administrative record is due no later than September 30, 2011.


