We are a small community we are also proud of our community our nation and our Post office we are also doing everything in our power to save the Post office you are right about our population a lot of Senior Citizens they have given their best in the fight for our Post office we also have some Senior Citizens who can't make it to the front yard no way to get to the Mail Box Beside the Road no way to put the Box up or no money to buy a Box. We have a lot of Senior and Veterans ~~on~~ on fixed income they know the effects you are facing on the financial problem you are having they are facing the same problem but it is worse for them they haven't had a raise in their checks they can't remember when they have to decide between food, medicine, electricity to keep warm they don't have to worry about gas going any higher, they can't afford a car, it not only Senior Citizens having a hard time we all are.

You are right on one thing you are not affiliated with government. Our administration in the speech the other night didn't mention the Post office about to lose all 120,000 jobs and closings.

Down Post offices. but they still are interested in Saving General Motors, Chrysler, and Ford. Looks to me like they would pay the Postal Services what they owe them. We need to have all jobs

We are concerned with Vandalism and theft in the area you stated we had minimum in our area in the last two years we have had the Community Broken into 3 times Stolen all the Copper in the Building, took all the Silverware and Cook ware. Broken windows out, the Picnic Shelter Vandalized Busted all light out Stolen Copper and Stolen 4 picnic tables torn the Panel off the Breaker Box. Do you really believe they would really be afraid to tear down a mail box beside the road or steal the mail. We have drugs in our area from Virginia side and Kentucky side. We are protected by our local Police from Drundy and Haysi. and State Police it is a rare occasion to see them in our area unless a wreck reported or something in that nature no day Patrols or night Patrols

The Roads in our area are not the Best in Virginia. They are not many places to get 2 wheels off the Road not to mention the whole car. We have stops in curves and blind spots in several places not safe to a Carrier to be stopping or pulling out in front of someone lot of Coal Trucks in our area.

We are growing in our Community. you are visit about the ~~new~~ New Road in our area

it has affected us more than it has helped us yet it affected 20 some families in our area they are trying to relocate in the Brooks. They Don't need this Burden Put up on them Now having to deal with this problem with the Postal Service.

You say you are saving 36,000 How can you put a price on safety by putting on a Carrier Stepping and pulling out in front of some way, or someone helping the mail at a Postal Box. This type of service is not needed in our area, and we don't need to go back in time we need to look ahead and to better our Selves in ever way we can

You say you can Run a Route for 12,000 or so have you checked the Price of gas lately the Price of a automobile the wear and tear of the vehicle. People don't do much Charity work any more.

I think our Community would rather see the mail delivered to the Post office by a Carrier and put in our existing Box No. and have certain hours to meet the Carrier there to receive packages and purchases what ever they need. This would save the Carrier a lot time on the road a lot safer for everyone in our area. We are going to have to make a lot of changes in our addresses this would be a help to everyone out give us

us more time to deal with the problems.  
I don't know what the figures in Dollars  
and Cents would add up to but it would  
have to save you a lot of money and put  
less burden on our Community.

We are willing to work with you in any way  
we can to save our post office. We don't want to
