THE BREAKS POST OFFICE IS THE POST OFFICE OF THE GRAND CANYON OF THE SOUTH. PEOPLE STAYING IN THE BREAKS PART ALL MAIL POST CARDS BACK HOME AND WANT IT STAMPED BREAKS, VA. WE THE PEOPLE OF THE BREAKS COMMUNITY DON'T ASK FOR MUCH, BUT PLEASE DON'T TAKE OUR POST OFFICE, OUR LIFE LINE AWAY. THE BREAKS POST OFFICE IS A HISTORICAL LANDMARK FOR THE BREAKS.

THE RULE ROUTE IS NOT IN THE MILAGE RANGE AS YOU SAY, I LIVE 1 1/2 MILES AWAY FROM THE BREAKS POST OFFICE AND THE LAST HOUSE UP MY HOLLOW IS 1/2 MILE FARTHER, SO THAT MEANS UP HAPPY HOLLOW IS 2 MILES ABOUT THE SAME OUT CROW PASS ROAD NOT COUNTING COW FORK DOWN TO THE KY.
